Dear Claire,

Further to our discussion on Friday and the handover of CDM information for the Grenfell project, I can confirm that there is no legal requirement for a CDM advisor.

The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2015 identifies only the following duty holders

- Client
- Principal Designer (where there is more than 1 contractor)
- Principal Contractor
- Designers
- Contractors

A number of local Authorities and private organisations are utilising a 'CDM Advisor' role, to ensure that either they, or organisations they have appointed, are working in compliance with the Regulations, but I can confirm that there is no legal requirement for this.

If at any point in time you feel a service such as this would be of benefit to KCTMO, please contact me as this is something we can provide, but I stress that there is no legal requirement.
