Jonathan,

I have had two recent meetings with two different NHBC Special Project Surveyors. Whilst nothing has been officially issued by NHBC both advised NHBC would no longer approve the use of PIR or Phenolic insulation in buildings taller than 18m. As it stands they will only accept the approach outlined by BCA (as attached):

- 1. Material of limited combustibility e.g. Rockwool
- 2. Evidence based approval from BRE or similar for the precise wall construction
- Actual fire test data

The above impacts on both our 190 Strand and Ph8a Stanmore projects.

I am advised a major UK SFS company (I would prefer not to state their name) conducted a fire test with RS5000 (Option 3 of BCA Guidance) and they had to abandon the test as the insulation caught on fire "very quickly".

Can you urgently review.
