Afternoon Gents,

As I'm sure that you are already aware Grenfell Tower project is now starting to gain some much needed momentum recently, particularly around the façade design area and planning. I've copied you all into this email trail as background information. The bottom line is that the client has just confirmed to planning that they are looking to proceed with the Reynobond Champagne colour (as shown on the mock-up) for the main body of the building and the cladding will be the 'cassette' fixing version. The bottom sections of the columns will also be GRC Column Casings (spec H40 130) which is the same as the original tender spec.

It is unlikely that the Planners will have any major issues with the above proposals as they have wanted 'cassette' fixings from the start. It may be wise not to order the champagne colour until we have 100% assurance but you can certainly start getting things rolling. Full design can now start. Therefore as a team we need to get the design team meetings going asap, which I will co-ordinate and send out meeting times

shortly. We know that Rob is the Contracts Manager on the project but can you confirm which other Harley team members will be involved please?
