### **FIRE SAFETY AND RISK ASSESSMENT EXPERIENCE**

I have 19 years fire safety experience with local Fire Authorities, in enforcement and auditing roles and 3 years as an independent fire risk assessor.

I worked as a Technical Fire Safety / Enforcement and Building Control officer for a Fire Authority Fire and Rescue Service responsible for auditing and the enforcement of all aspects of the Fire Safety Order and its predecessor the Fire Precautions Act 1971. Upon leaving the Fire Service I have worked as an independent Fire Safety Consultant and risk assessor carrying out fire risk assessments of buildings and other fire related fixed systems checks, also undertaking fire investigation and producing reports for owners and insurance companies.

I have experience of being the building occupiers representative in meetings with architects and construction companies for new building works and refurbishments and representing the responsible person in negotiations with enforcing bodies. Fire risk assessments that I have undertaken and the significant findings there of have been audited by several different local Fire Authorities and also OFSTED inspectors and insurance assessors. To date these completed Fire Risk Assessments have been judged "not found wanting in any area" and "suitable and sufficient" to cover all articles of the Fire Safety Order.
