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## Dear Anju

Thank you for your telephone call this afternoon, if it is at all possible please could I accompany yourself and the RBKC Housing team to the meeting(s) you are to have with the London Fire Brigade (LFB), there will be no costs incurred by RBKC from myself if I am allowed to participate in these meetings.

I have undertaken the all TMO residential Fire Risk Assessments (FRAs) over the two years and before this I worked with one other person undertaking the TMO FRAs, so I have a very good knowledge of the residential housing stock of the TMO and have visited nearly all the residential properties.

I had 19 years fire safety experience with local Fire Authorities, in enforcement and auditing roles before I became an independent fire risk assessor, so I have a good understanding of Fire Service policies and procedures for enforcing fire safety issues and the national guideline that govern enforcement action. I have also accompanied LFB enforcement officers undertaking Audit inspections under the Fire Safety Order of TMO buildings.

As an ex fire officer I have attended fires in residential buildings so have an understanding of human behavior in fire situations and also know the operational procedures that the fire service undertake at an operation incident, including high rise procedures for fighting fires in tower blocks etc.

I have undertaken courses in fire safety both as a serving fire officer and as an assessor, including fire engineering courses and worked as a Fire Service Building Control liaison officer so know the Building Regulations as well as the technical standards of fixed systems within buildings.

I have experience of being the building occupier's representative in meetings with architects and construction companies for new building works and refurbishments and representing the responsible person in negotiations with enforcing bodies. To date the negotiation's have resulted in enforcement actions being withdrawn or compromises being reached without the need for extended legal action by any enforcement bodies. In the cases of over provision by contractors or not providing the statutory levels needed to comply with the relevant British Standards negotiations have resulted in satisfactory outcomes so far.
