**Subject:** Building Surveyor responsibility at Glenfell House

Dear Nicholas

Thank you for our conversation this evening where you confirmed that you would authorise an independent building surveyor to operate on behalf of RBKC.

I have been in contact with the Duty Borough Emergency Command (BEC) to seek that support (Mark Sawyer). They are in the process of selecting a suitably experienced surveyor and it is hoped that they will be available to meet with John Allen from RBKC in order to conduct a formal handover which will be accompanied by MPS officers. This is likely to take place starting at 12pm tomorrow to allow time for the BEC to identify a suitable person.

I do not fully understand how the BEC emergency protocol is invoked but I understand that John Barrowdale is the Local Authority Incident Gold Command. It will be important that the formalities between the BEC, RBKC and the local authority providing the mutual aid support are agreed as soon as possible tomorrow to ensure there remains clear accountability for the building. I would be grateful if you could ensure the necessary officers are available to complete any formalities.

Thanks for your help and continued support at this difficult time.
