Please see attached (and copied below) the actions arising from this afternoon's Ministerial

meeting on the Grenfell Tower fire.

- 1. KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA BOROUGH COUNCIL to liaise with local religious and other groups to establish whether there were likely to be more residents in the building than the Council were aware of.
- 2. DEPARTMENT FOR WORK AND PENSIONS to liaise with the METROPOLITAN POLICE. AND CHELSEA BOROUGH COUNCIL and DEPARTMENT COMMUNITIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT to share information on individuals who may have been resident in the Tower, with the aim of urgently completing an accurate list.

- 3. MINISTRY OF JUSTICE, HOME OFFICE, METROPOLITAN POLICE and DEPARTMENT FOR COMMUNITIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT to liaise on how the identification of bodies can continue alongside the coming inquiry.
- 4. KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA BOROUGH COUNCIL to liaise with DEPARTMENT FOR COMMUNITIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT on guaranteeing the provision of <u>local</u> accommodation in the medium-term to all those who have lost their homes in the incident, and to provide clear advice on this at the next meeting (on Friday 16 June).
- 5. KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA BOROUGH COUNCIL to liaise on issues relating to the provision of public services (finance, benefits, postal services etc) with the relevant Government departments, including the DEPARTMENT FOR WORK AND PENSIONS, HM TREASURY and the DEPARTMENT FOR BUSINESS, ENERGY AND INDUSTRIAL STRATEGY.
- 6. HM TREASURY and DEPARTMENT FOR WORK AND PENSIONS to test robustly that services relating to finance and benefits are being provided to those affected.
- 7. METROPOLITAN POLICE to lead a multi-agency comms briefing tomorrow to set out that this will be a Police-led investigation, and to clarify that the investigation will be independent from Government.
- 8. HO COMMS, in liaison with No10 COMMS to provide advice on potential options for national marking of the incident, drawing on past experiences.

There is likely to be a further meeting of the group tomorrow and a calling notice will issue in due course.
