Good morning Claire,

Hope you are well. David Ring from Just Energy Solutions has passed me your details, further to a meeting we had last week.

I work within Rockwool's Refurbishment & Regeneration team which is focused on supporting in the delivery of new build and external thermal refurbishment schemes through the application of stone wool insulation systems, and we have developed a product suite so that we are able to offer a whole building solution including external wall insulation and rain-screen cladding systems.

All stone wool insulation comes with a euro class fire rating of A1, and therefore our systems are particularly suited to high-rise refurbishment in accordance with BR 135. I was hoping to enquire whether any specification had yet been set for the insulated rainscreen being installed on the Grenfell Tower refurbishment.

Our systems have been used on the Edward Wood Estate next to Westfield in Shepherd's Bush, and our London office is in Hammersmith so I would welcome the opportunity to meet and discuss further.
