Recent stabbing event at Grenfell Tower

As you may already be aware, sadly stabbing took place in Grenfell Tower on 23 September 2016. The victims were a father and his son, who sustained a serious injury, and this incident had an effect on the whole family unit. The family were supported by the TMO, police and social services in moving to new accommodation.

We are writing to inform you that a 28-year-old suspect was arrested on 2 November in Liverpool and charged in relation to the incident. This individual has been remanded in custody and both the police and victims thank local residents for all their help in this matter. If anyone has any further information about the incident, please do not hesitate to call Notting Hill CID on [REDACTED]

Grenfell Tower is a secure building and has two security doors leading to the lift lobby area. In order to keep the building secure please do not provide access to people who you do not know and who are not visiting your flat. If your door buzzer sounds, please make sure you only allow visitors known to you to your property and not strangers into the rest of the building.

The entrance door at Grenfell Tower was recently damaged from, we believe, being propped open to allow free access to anyone. Under no circumstances should either of the security doors on the ground floor be propped open as anyone doing this is putting the security of all residents at risk.
