This is to inform you that, can someone from RBKC explain to me that, since 14th June 2017, we came from near death and Hell on earth experiences and worse has happened to our lives and we lost six neighbours from 18th Floor including 12 years and 5 years old boys due to this catastrophic unprecedented mandate disaster in Grenfell Tower the country has ever seen.

Despite all the request made to you and appealed directly to everybody that 9th months on, can you let me know urgently as to why RBKC never allocated care and support worker for us.

I shall be very grateful to you both that you send Christine Mee today to my temporary accommodation urgently. This is to inform you that our health and well-being seriously affecting and Christine Mee MUST visit to my temporary accommodation today this is paramount important.
