IN CASE OF FIRE

If you discover a fire in your home you should:

1. Leave your flat immediately, closing doors behind you.
2. Call the fire service on 999.
3. Use the fire escape if you have one.
4. Call the fire service for advice on 999.
5. Do not use the lift as they may not give signals of fire.

If you see or hear a fire elsewhere in the flat:

1. Stay in your flat.
2. Call the fire service on 999 or 112.
3. Do not use the lift as they may not give signals of fire.

Always use in a commercial area:

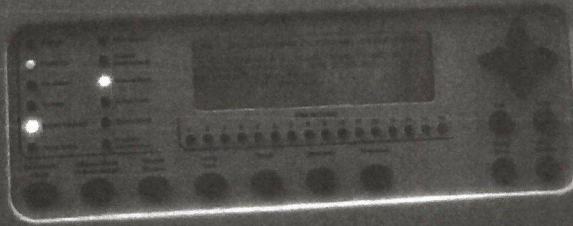
1. Call the fire service on 999 or 112.
2. Leave the building as soon as you can.
3. Do not use the lift as they may not give signals of fire.

DO NOT:

1. Use the lift.
2. Return to collect personal belongings.
3. Smoke.
