We have collated the details below from the asbestos register and have also included a note stating that no visible asbestos was found at Grenfell Tower within the common parts.

134 Grenfell Tower – Artex decorative ceiling coating contains a trace of asbestos.

Grenfell Tower – No visible asbestos was found during the external and communal area survey of this site.

Hurstway Walk – Access panels (4 identified) – labelled.

Testerton Walk – Access panels (4 identified) – labelled.

Barandon Walk – Access panels (4 identified) – labelled.

Grenfell Walk & Upper Grenfell Walk – Access panels (8 identified) – labelled.

Talbot Grove House – Presumed asbestos cement pipes and cowls from bin chute on roof - Blocks 2 and 3.
