Fay Edwards, who is chairperson of the [Kensington and Chelsea Tenant Management Organisation \(KCTMO\)](#), received a British Empire Medal in the Queen's New Year's honours list.

The organisation looks after the maintenance and upkeep of nearly 10,000 council properties in the Royal borough.

She has been chairman since 2012, and a member of the board for nearly six years. She was nominated for the gong, for Services to the Community, by KCTMO CEO Robert Black.

The 76-year-old, who has lived in North **Kensington** for 25 years, continued: "When I found out I was in shock.


"I couldn't believe it but people said I deserved it."
