Subject: Fire safety at Grenfell Tower

Good morning Mr Daffarn,

Thank you for your various communications on the matter of fire safety, access and parking and I confirm that resident safety is of paramount importance to all parties.

As previously advised all enquiries relating to the operational delivery of the KALC project should now be directed to Colin Chiles of Leadbitter. Grenfell Tower Regeneration Project enquiries should be directed to myself and Paul Dunkerton and general estate enquiries should be directed to Siobhan Rumble.

With regard to fire safety at Grenfell Tower and for that matter the remainder of the estate, and as advised at the Estate Management Board meeting, the fire safety and management arrangements form part of the respective projects and at present there is no impact upon the access routes that LFEPAs would utilise in the event of an incident.

We shall also be reviewing this aspect of the projects as they evolve and progress and will ensure via the project teams that appropriate provision is made for fire safety.

On the matter of contractor vehicles parking within the access roads, I have requested that colleagues ensure that this does not occur except where designated parking bays exist.
