Dear all,

Kensington and Chelsea are looking for staff to support their ongoing response over tomorrow and the weekend.

The requirements, from London boroughs, are to find 4 x LALOs, 4x Rest Centre Mangers/ staff and 4 x BECC staff for each shift.

Please let me know if you would be available to cover a role and which shift: Friday (0900-2000 or 2000-0900), Saturday (0900-2000 or 2000-0900), Sunday (0900-2000 or 2000-0900).

You are all fully trained and prepared but feel free to come to myself, Simon or Sophie tomorrow for a briefing/ run through if you'd like. Please also check with your line manager if volunteering in work time.

You will have seen the devastating scenes from the incident over the last few days and note that these are likely to be traumatic environments to work in.

Please recognise this if volunteering and speak to myself if you have any concerns beforehand. Obviously any support would be greatly appreciated by the borough and community.
