Residential block of flats of eleven floors, twenty five metres by twenty five metres. One hundred percent of five roomed flat on fifth floor damaged by fire, twenty five percent of five roomed flat on sixth floor damaged by fire. Approximately thirty square metres of external cladding between fifth and eighth floors damaged by fire, dry rising main, four jets, thermal imaging camera, forward information board, breathing apparatus, extended duration breathing apparatus, breaking in gear, Metropolitan Police air support unit for video downlink. Approximately two hundred persons self evacuated. Nine persons assisted from flats on floors seven, eight, nine and ten to ground floor level by breathing apparatus crews. One infant and one elderly female treated on scene by London Ambulance [REDACTED] [REDACTED] One elderly male treated on scene by London Ambulance Service for minor injuries from falling debris. One elderly female removed to hospital [REDACTED] and shock. High Rise and Fire Survival Guidance Procedure implemented. All persons accounted for.
