

1. I have never been an employee of Manse Masterdor Ltd. My involvement with the company formerly known as Manse Masterdor commenced during late November 2014 when my employer Synseal Extrusions Ltd. Acquired the assets of L B Plastics Ltd., Heage, Derbyshire. As Group Manufacturing Director for Synseal Extrusions Ltd I became responsible for Production at Masterdor Ltd.
2. In relation to the reports I provided to the Metropolitan Police:
 - a) I requested copies of all Fire Testing and Field Assessment reports from Mr. Jim Duncan in March 2018. Mr Duncan was the keeper of the reports.
 - b) To the best of my knowledge I was given copies of all available reports.
3. I had no role in the development of the Suredor Fire Door. The Suredor Fire Door had been developed prior to Synseal Extrusions Ltd. acquiring the assets of L B Plastics Ltd in November 2014 as above.
4. I had no role in the fire resistance and cold smoke testing of the Suredor Fire Doors.
5. I don't know the names of those people specifically responsible for the design, development and testing of the Suredor Fire Door.
6. I don't know which employees or Directors were provided with fire test reports in the period between 2006 and 2014.
7. I don't know what changes were made to the manufacturing process of Sredoor Fire Doors from the commencement of manufacture until 2013.
8. To the best of my knowledge there wer no changes made to the manufacturing process of Suredor Fire Doors between 14th June 2017 and April 2018.
9. I don't know the difference between the Suredor FD30 and the Suredor FD30S. I understand that any FD30S door should undergo additional smoke testing as well as Fire Resistance testing.
10. In relation to John Tapscott, Mike Hudson and Jim Duncan:
 - a) I don't know what their specific roles and responsibilities were between 2006 and 2014.
 - b) I don't know what their specific involvement or knowledge was of any Fire Resistance and/or cold smoke leakage testing carried out on Suredor Fire Doors.
 - c) I don't know what their specific involvement or knowledge was of changes to the manufacturing process or design of Suredor Fire Doors.
