I have discussed my window report with David Gibson, and what he has suggested what would be useful is some reassurance from yourself on the overheating issue.

This is along the lines that if the residents are given specific management details, ie windows should be used in the tilt position generally if there is risk of any small children being in the room alone – if the residents followed this advice and use curtains to prevent solar gain – will the situation be worse than currently in terms of the overheating? Does your modelling show this?

Obviously Rydon will be responsible for getting the proposal through building regulations, and the TMO are only approving the type of windows – but this is part of the equation.
