This was the proposal that was suggested by Alex, which would mean that we would not have an AOV system to maintain. I do not know whether it meets fire or building regulations, but as the first step can you please run it passed Carl in terms of meeting his FRA requirements. I will run it passed my consultant once we have Carl's feedback.

The proposal is essentially to remove the AOVs, but provide an open area where the existing AOVs are – it seems that there are 2 opening windows per glazed atrium. Is this going to meet the fire requirements, or is it a non-starter?

The idea of course is to ensure we meet the regulations, whilst removing the monitoring/servicing element if possible.

I am back on Friday 31 October, so hopefully you can give me Carl's feedback on my return.
