Dear Claire

Thank you.

I had a meeting last Friday with Pilgrim Tucker, the Unite official who is organising the Grenfell Unite residents group.

She was concerned that she has written on behalf of her group to the TMO but has received no response. I pointed out that she has no authority to act on their behalf to the TMO and that the proper channel of communication for residents is directly to the TMO, through their Residents' Association or through their ward councillors. I advised her that the ward councillors hold two surgeries each month – the second and fourth Saturday between 10 am and 12 noon - at the Leisure Centre just opposite Grenfell Tower and residents are free to attend those.

I also pointed out that there is a drop in session next Thursday and that if her residents wished to attend that as a group, they could do so. I asked how large her group is and she claimed about 25 households. I pointed out that the block has 120 flats so that is not a very large percentage. I asked why they needed to be involved as a group and she said it was important that they met with someone in higher authority. I said I thought Peter Maddison might be at the drop in session on Thursday so maybe they could see him then. She claimed not to know who Peter is or his role in the TMO.

She did not understand why the works have to be finished by October and was surprised when I said that as this is when the TMO switches the heating on for the winter, residents could not have any heating until the new heating and hot water system has been fully installed. She seemed also unaware that the pipes will all be boxed in once the new system is up and running and has been tested for any problems. Maybe these are two matters that need to be communicated to all the residents, especially to those who are refusing access to their flats.

I hope this helps.
