Dear Ms Jevans,

I wish to make a formal complaint against the TMO and the Estate Management at Lancaster West for allowing a dangerous build up of household refuse on the walkway level at entry/exit to Grenfell Tower.

This rubbish now constitutes a significant fire risk as a number of mattresses have appeared over the weekend and the build up of rubbish, over the past few weeks, is making the entrance to our building look truly awful in addition to being a serious health and safety matter.

While it is quite clear that no-one at the TMO gives a damn about the well-being of the residents of Grenfell Tower we shouldn't have to tolerate the Estate Management running our residential amenity into the ground and allowing dangerous levels of household rubbish to escalate.

Please can you inform me when the TMO plan to remove the rubbish from the entrance hallway at Grenfell Tower and tell me how you intend to address the build up of rubbish in the future?
