Dear Peter,

Apologies for the delayed response, it has been a busy day.

Apologies also for any confusion caused when you read paragraph 4. Perhaps it was not stating clearly enough that the requests we laid out on 11th August were the requests we had of yourself and TMO. We were asking you to organise monthly meetings with residents, and to invite Rydon if you so wished. We largely remain unconvinced that the community engagement strategy at Grenfell Tower has changed in any way, as it occurs to us like it is the residents group who are driving community engagement still. One of the things we are looking for tonight is to know how TMO are going to change this, and become proactive. In the absence of any movement from yourselves, we do have a proposal for further engagement meetings over the coming 6 weeks which we are willing to run you through tonight.

The intention of the meeting tonight is to discuss the relationship between TMO and residents, and to hear and discuss the progress you and TMO have made regarding our requests and the problems at Grenfell

Tower. We did not believe it appropriate or wish a Rydon representative to attend for that conversation. It may well be appropriate for Rydon to get involved at a later date.

If you would like to organise a subsequent meeting with Mr Lawrence or a Rydon representative, please suggest some dates by reply or suggest some dates to the group tonight.

It would be very useful and appropriate for Mr Singh to attend.

Dear David

I am sorry for any confusion, however, in your message dated 11th August you stated the following:
"4. We would like to set up regular monthly meetings between TMO (Peter Maddison) and residents for the life of the construction works, beginning now. This can be facilitated through the Compact once it is formalised. This could also include a senior Rydon representative. The purpose being to have the project run as smoothly as possible, and to have us work well together. Please use us as a residents group and work with us."

I interpreted this as a request from you that a senior representative of Rydon should attend the meeting.

Given the wide range of issues that you want to discuss, I think that it makes sense that the key people responsible for the service attend so we can have an informed discussion and agree a way forward.

I would like Simon Lawrence to attend this evening, so we can resolve some of the operational issues that you have raised – such as working hours and site cleanliness. He is also the best person to deal with any technical questions relating to the works.

I would also like Kiran Singh (Head of Neighbourhood Management) to attend as he is responsible for the Housing management issues, such as tenancy issues, estate cleaning and estate security.

I would be grateful if you would confirm that both Simon and Kiran attend this evening's meeting.
