Dear Judith - Happy New Year

Presumably as part of the preparation works for KALC the playground at the base of Grenfell Tower was closed off last week.

This creates considerably difficulties for the nursery who are required as part of their OFSTED registration to provide outdoor play opportunities for the children every day. Unless we do this OFSTED could be close us down.

There was no liaison with the nursery about this and the nursery manager, Shirley Sylvester, has not been given any details of whom to contact with concerns, etc.

We would like to have part of the playground re-instated temporarily until we move out at Easter or an alternative, safe playspace provided.

Could you forward my concerns to the appropriate persons so that a speedy resolution can be achieved.
