A word of warning. Eman has already told me about Mr. Daffarn's approach to her. His *modus operandi* is confrontation, confrontation, confrontation, aggression and personal insults to everyone involved from us as ward councillors to the TMO to the Council. He [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and has nothing better to do with his time, so his current mission is to stir up the residents at Silchester and at Balfour Burleigh & Treverton to cause as much mischief as possible. And he gives out a lot of misinformation that just frightens residents

unnecessarily. He has told the elderly residents at Whitchurch House that they are going to be knocked down – just because he has mis-read the map. They are not included at all. I have had to ask the TMO to re-assure them all.

Unfortunately his tactics won the day at Grenfell Tower, which is most unfortunate – but it did leave the residents in stand-off position against the TMO for three months when things could have been sorted out much earlier and without all the aggro.

Sorry about not getting back about the applications, I am completely snowed under with stuff at the moment. Can you wait a few more days?

BTW is it correct that Peabody want to refuse access to Frinstead residents to the private garden? I believe this is so and, if you agree, I will write directly to the Chief Executive of Peabody because that is absolutely not on.
