Subject: Re: KAA and anti social behaviour on Lancaster West Estate

Dear Ms Rieder,

Yesterday afternoon the Grenfell Tower playground was full of pupils from KAA who were shouting "Fuck off Ms Jacob" and other obscenities at the top of their voices. It took the intervention of a number of the residents from Grenfell Tower to bring some order to this situation.

Every day our playground (which is designed for the use of the Grenfell Under 3 Creche and local children under 11 years old who are accompanied by their parents) is invaded by pupils from KAA sometimes resulting in our local playground users having to leave the premises so they are not subjected to listening to obscene language, pupils fighting each with each other and other thuggish anti-social behaviour.

Last week my neighbour, who is nearly 75 years old and not in the most robust of health, told me that she was terrified by groups of KAA children running around the base of Grenfell Tower as school ended.

Please can you inform me why your school does not even have a single staff member or community police officer standing outside our part of the school building to ensure that we are not treated in this manner and that your pupils disperse in an orderly and respectful manner around Grenfell Tower and along Station walk?

Please can you explain to me what actions the KAA will be taking to ensure that we are not subjected to this anti-social behaviour in the future and how our community may be made to feel safe at the end of the school day?

As ordinary residents of our estate we know that RBKC and our landlord, the TMO, treat us with contempt but we do not think it is fair that the KAA should also act in this way. We have the right to enjoy our lives and tenancies with a modicum of quite and order and this is clearly not the case at the moment.
