I am sure you are aware that Cllr Blakeman in a recent widely circulated email claimed that the EMB "has not ben functioning since December 2012"

I would be most grateful if you could clarify the context of this statement for me to the best of your ability. For instance, is it the case that the EMB has not met at all since December 2012, or rather that meetings were scheduled as usual but had to be adjourned as inquorate on some or all occasions? If the latter, on which occasions were meetings adjourned as inquorate?

If there are any minutes of meetings, or records of adjourned meetings, scheduled between December 2012 and June 2013 I would be grateful if you could arrange to have copies of these records sent to me, preferably as email attachments, as soon as possible.

I would be grateful if you could also clarify whether the sudden and unexpected scheduling of a board member election so soon after the December AGM was caused by an inability to achieve a quorum at board meetings in recent months.
