Dear Mr. Maddison

Mr. Fahid spoke to me at the Residents' Conference and he has also spoken to Cllr. Atkinson. He has had the boiler installed in the hallway, much against his will. The works to this installation are still not fully complete as it is not yet connected up. He has asked for it to be moved to the kitchen but has been advised that, as he is no longer connected either to the old heating system or the new heating system, he should have the new boiler connected and then the situation will be "reviewed".

He is most unhappy with this suggestion and believes that he is being bullied into keeping the unit in the hallway. I disagree that he is being bullied but I agree wholeheartedly with him that this is not a satisfactory response, since it will inevitably lead to him being advised that it is no longer possible to remove the new unit into the kitchen.

I am therefore writing on his behalf to ask that works to the unit in the hallway cease and that it be moved into the kitchen. Mr. Fahid understands that he will have delays before the flat is connected to the new heating and hot water system and he has said that he will accept that situation.
