I just thought I'd drop you a note to clarify a point that was made by Mr Daffarn at the KALC Residents Forum regarding the removal of the stairwell to Grenfell and whether it had planning permission or not. I've spoken to Mr George who has confirmed that the removal of the stairwell does indeed have planning permission, however he can understand how this e-mail may appear confusing as it referred to doing this in conjunction with the Grenfell works, which of course hasn't happened yet, but it didn't mean that planning permission hadn't been achieved rather an expectation of how the works would proceed on site.

I shall ensure this is noted in the minutes as a follow-up so when they are circulated forum attendees can be reassured that Leadbitters have not undertaken work that they haven't got planning permission for.
