Nothing is simple as you know, however they have agreed that "approx" 25 residents who want it in the kitchen can have it in the kitchen this will be installed over the next 4 months ..... They will have to have their water cut off and disruption to their kitchen and cabinets etc

At the end of that – probably October, we will meet again, and then those residents who have the unit in the hall can decide whether or not to change or stick.

However the important point is that they have agreed to get on with the work, because it all needs to be done so that they can get the new water system working and the boilers done, but they do have to complete the residents work first .....

I have suggested they form themselves into a proper residents association, and said the Council will help them to do that, and then they can do other things too.

We also discussed the security system and some of the other issues .... All of which you are aware of

I agreed we would all meet again in October, (when the work is almost completed) and in the meantime they will have more regular meetings with the "group"

It is a slow start .....

Fingers crossed that the TMO actually get on and build on all of this .....
