It was agreed that if residents would like the HIU in their kitchen then this will be made to happen by the TMO, for those who have not had the installation completed already.

It was agreed that Victoria would return in October to meet with the parties again, to discuss what should happen for the people who feel like they were forced or threatened in to having the unit in their hallways up to this point.

It is possible that we may need to discuss the situation for those people before that time, as the few conversations I have had today suggest there may be a groundswell of feeling about this. But that may depend on the kitchen based solution, as no one has yet had it done to know how well it will work.

Victoria also suggested the group apply to be an RA. She recommended and suggested we apply for that status. She is clearly passionate about the power of community, and continually encouraged us to work together for the betterment of the area.

We also discussed some of the other matters around security, TMO responsiveness when water services fail, Rydon maintaining the cleanliness of the building, etc.

It was a good and inspiring meeting and outcome, and we are very grateful for all your support in helping us to get here.
