Dear Robert

At the Board meeting we were assured that had the TMO been aware of the two new-borns at Grenfell Tower, appropriate arrangements would have been made for respite for them and their mothers.

I have now spoken to one of those mothers. She assures me that she did advise the TMO that she was about to have a baby and did ask about respite arrangements. However, she was told that all that could be provided was the show flat, which was also open to other residents for respite. She referred to the special needs (alcoholism) of some of the more vulnerable residents of the Tower and it seemed that they could be using the facility at the same time. Clearly she was worried that the show flat was not suitable for her or the baby.

I am very concerned that the Board and I were misled at meeting about this case. Cllr Lasharie has not yet spoken to the other mother so I do not know whether she also told the TMO about her baby.
