Dear Sacha

I hope that the enquiry will

- Review all the written communications to determine whether they were of sufficient clarity for everyone – including residents with poor English – to understand and whether, when situations changed (such as the preferred HIU location), the changes and the reasons for them were explained clearly enough.
- Consider whether communications between the on-site Rydon resident liaison team and the TMO were adequate – for example, their failure to report to the TMO that there would be two new-borns returning to their homes at the height of the refurbishment programme. As one mother reported her concern to them for her baby's hearing and lung development because of the daily excessive dust and loud hammering and banging. She had to take her baby to family and friends for peace and quiet. The other mother said that her situation was embarrassing because she was unable to breastfeed her baby in peace with Rydon workers coming in and out of her flat.
- Consider whether the Rydon resident liaison team were sufficiently well trained to understand their role.
- While completely accepting that, while some residents were extremely abusive and aggressive and made open meetings unworkable, consider whether engaging with a group of residents through a TMO-selected representative group could have avoided residents' feeling of isolation and that they were being "picked off" individually.

I would probably have had more to contribute but was unaware of its time frame.
