I have now had a report from the Grenfell Tower Funday.

The ponies did attend, but not for very long because one pony was spooked, threw a young girl and an emergency ambulance had to be called for her. Apparently she was treated in the ambulance for about an hour before she was taken to hospital. I have been told that she was not seriously hurt – but I would like to know whether any report on the incident has been made, including an update on her condition

I am told that there were also some health and safety issues concerning the barbecue, but I do not know precisely what. The boxing club did not attend. It was said that it was apparent that no one had carried out a risk assessment of the event. On the plus side, I am told that the atmosphere was very good, it was very friendly and everyone had a good time.

I would be interested to know whether Westway Stables responded to Ms. Blackburn's e-mail about health and safety issues. It would be good to know also whether Ms. Tucker, the Unite the Union organiser of the event, had any public liability insurance in place and, given that the event took place on Council land, whether the Council would have been held liable otherwise for any untoward incident.
