I am writing on behalf of Unite the Union's Community members in Grenfell Tower, on the Lancaster West Estate.

As you may be aware residents of Grenfell Tower have serious concerns regarding the works that are currently taking place in their homes, and have asked that a member of the senior management team with responsibility for the works programme meet with them to discuss their concerns and how these concerns can be addressed.

At least 60 residents have met, discussed, and have the following requests of the TMO:

1. The 'HUI', or boiler unite to be hidden where the existing water tank is located, as per the Rydon consultation of 2014.
2. For there to be no exposed piping in the properties, as per the Rydon consultation of 2014
3. For the standard of work to be completed to a standard as good, or better, than the standard of work people already had in their homes.

I would be very grateful if you could confirm that a member of the senior management team will be available to meet with residents, and suggest some possible dates for this meeting. In view of the fact that many residents are refusing access to the contractors until their concerns are addressed it would seem wise that this meeting is scheduled for as soon as possible.
