Subject: Publication of Enforcement Notice - Hazelwood Tower

Rob,

I am writing to you to request a meeting with myself Robert Black CE of K&C TMO to discuss the two Enforcement Notices that were served on K&C TMO following the fire at Adair Tower.

I would also like to request that the Enforcement Notice for Hazelwood Tower is not placed on the public register until such time as we have had an opportunity to meet and discuss the substantive issue in the notice, that the ventilation system does not work and requires alteration.

It is our belief that the ventilation system in the building does work and does not require changing and rather than formally challenge this through the Magistrates Court it would be preferable to meet and discuss what has lead the LFB to reach its conclusion and discuss with you amending the notice.

I have attached a film that was taken of the fire this has the advantage of both showing how the fire progressed, how it was extinguished and how this then lead to the ventilation system being compromised and the ability of the stairwells to remain smoke free.

I would also like to discuss with you the protocol around Staying Put in the case of a fire in a tower block, the reality of what actually took place in the case of the fire in Adair Tower both in terms of the actions of the residents and LFB.

I look forward to hearing from you and I do hope that until we meet that the Enforcement Notice for Hazelwood Tower is not published on the register.
