With regard to the attached letter, while I welcome consideration of the petition at the Scrutiny Committee Meeting on 6 January, I think it would be helpful to hear also from a representative of the Grenfell Tower Compact.

To the best of my knowledge the only councillors who have spoken to any of the residents **during the construction period** have been Victoria Borwick MP, Robert Atkinson, Beinazir Lasharie and me. Residents have very strong feelings about the way the construction with them in residence has been handled and representations made by both Victoria and the ward councillors have not been very well received by the Council, the TMO or the contractors, Rydon. It really is necessary to hear from some of the residents themselves to get the true picture.
