The TMO Board met on Monday night, one of the items on the agenda was Grenfell Tower and the impending discussion at Scrutiny Committee on the 6th Jan.

The Board agreed:

- TMO needed to finish the project
 - TMO to carry out a review to see what has worked and not- i.e. lessons learned
 - Usually this would be officers doing it but Board Members wanted to be involved which adds the challenge and independence. Paula Fance (independent Board Member appointed by RBKC) wants to be involved and adds value to her regeneration work, she was very supportive, Kush will get involved and a few others as could Judith – they can listen to the issues
- The Board feels this is a TMO matter and wants to deal with it itself.
They will then share the outcomes of their report with Scrutiny later in the year.

I'm sure Mr Black will raise this as on Wednesday but if not I thought I would share it with you as it would be useful if a suggested outcome of the discussion at Scrutiny Committee could support the TMO and the due process they are undertaking.
