# Part Two - Articles of the Constitution

## **ARTICLE 1 – THE CONSTITUTION**

#### 1.01 The Constitution

This Constitution and its appendices is the Constitution of the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

#### 1.02 Powers of the Council

The Council exercises all its powers and duties in accordance with the law and this Constitution.

# 1.03 **Purpose of the Constitution**

The purpose of the Constitution is to:

- (a) enable the Council to exercise its functions as a statutory body;
- (b) enable the Council to provide clear leadership to the community in partnership with local people, businesses and other organisations;
- (c) support the active involvement of local people in the process of local authority decision-making;
- (d) help Councillors represent their constituents more effectively;
- (e) enable decisions to be made efficiently and effectively;
- (f) create a powerful and effective means of holding decision-makers to public account;
- (g) ensure that no one will review or scrutinise a decision in which they were directly involved;
- (h) ensure that those responsible for decision-making are clearly identifiable to local people and that they explain the reasons for decisions; and
- (i) provide a means of improving the delivery of services to the community.

### 1.04 Interpretation and Review of the Constitution

- (a) Where the Constitution permits the Council to choose between different courses of action, the Council always chooses that option which it thinks is closest to the purposes stated above.
- (b) The Council monitors and evaluates the operation of the Constitution as set out in Article 14.
