Further to your call regarding the cladding at Grenfell Tower, whilst it is disappointing that the Champagne colour is being questioned at this stage, we are keen to resolve the issue as soon as possible. I will come onto deadlines later.

As you know, the options which you list have been looked at extensively with your planning team.

With regards to alternatives – the three 'best candidates' were shown on site (see attached jpeg). There was a consensus that the Metallics looked best, given the nature of the existing building and the aspiration for a natural material.

We consider that given the extensive discussions on this to date, if something 'more grey' has been requested, the Smoke Silver Metallic would be the alternative that should be considered. We are very concerned with opening up all the options again given the extremely tight time scales we now have to order the product.

I would note that the cladding needs to be ordered by Friday 3rd of October at the very latest, which means this really needs resolving next week.

I hope this helps in your discussions.

Please keep me updated with the outcome.

Dear Amy,

As discussed, a concern has been raised by one of my seniors about the use of the 'Champagne' Metallic Duragloss sample for the main building panels on Grenfell Tower. A preference has been expressed for a grey.

I'm conscious that we already have a number of grey colour samples from yourselves. I would be grateful to know if you are happy for me to put these in front of our Executive Director as an alternative to the Champagne. The samples we have are the following:

RAL 7012 "Basalt Grey" (already used on window frames)

RAL 9022 "Pearl Light Grey" Matt (already used on the panels on the lower two floors)

RAL 7035

RAL 7047

RAL 9002 "Grey White Matt"

Reynobond- Smoke Silver Metallic

Reynobond- Stainless Steel Brushed Look

Reynobond- Vintage Brushed Look

I would be grateful if you could let me know if you have any issue with me putting these forward as alternatives, or if there are any you would rather not be used.

Also, I cannot seem to locate samples of the 'RAL 9010 Pure White Matt' or the cladding 'BCM GRC Cladding 248 S-HYGRC'. Are you able to forward samples of these for our records? These are less urgent while we resolve the other colour issue.
