

# WARRANTY

This Warranty is issued by Alcoa Architectural Products for a period of **xxx years** to the customer identified in this Certificate ("Customer") and applies to the PVDF 70/30 3-coat finish (30 to 45 µ) on the composite material REYNOBOND® Architecture 6mm (the "Product") and installed at the property (the "Property") identified in the application submitted by the Customer. Warranty coverage is subject to the terms, conditions, limitations, remedies and legal rights set forth below :

1. The Warranty Period shall commence on the date of Alcoa Architectural Products' initial shipment of the Product.
2. The Warranty concerns pre-painted aluminium for REYNOLUX®/REYNOBOND® produced in accordance to following norms :
  - Substrate : EN 1396
  - Coating : ECCA T1 - T2 - T3 - T5 - T6 - T7.
3. Alcoa Architectural Products warrants that during the Warranty Period the paint will not peel, blister, chip, check, or crack (except for such slight crazing or cracking as may occur on edges or break bends at the time of fabrication of the Product).
4. Alcoa Architectural Products warrants that, when installed in absence of standing or ponding water, the Product will not chalk in excess of a numerical rating of 8 during the Warranty Period when measured in accordance with the standard procedures specified in ASTM D-659-80.
5. Alcoa Architectural Products warrants that, when installed in absence of standing or ponding water, the Product will not fade or change colour during the Warranty Period in excess of 5 colour difference units when measured according to ASTM C-2244-93 on exposed paint surfaces which have been cleaned of external deposits and chalk. Non-uniform fading and colour changes are not covered by this Warranty if they result from the coated surfaces being unequally exposed to sunlight and the elements.
6. This Warranty does not cover damage or deterioration caused by any occurrence beyond Alcoa Architectural Products' control, including without limitation, fire, vandalism, radiation, foreign substances in the atmosphere, mishandling, acts of God, floods, exposure to corrosive atmospheres (such as those contaminated with chemical fumes or salt spray), intermittent or continual submersion in water or any other liquid or solid material, damage from wind, deliberate damage, improper handling by erectors, improper fabrication of the Product, electrolytic action, mechanical damage or any other physical damage. For purposes of this Warranty, Product shall be deemed to have been installed in an atmosphere contaminated with salt spray, if installed within one kilometer (measured from mean high tide) of any body of salt water.
7. This Warranty does not cover damage or deterioration resulting from moisture contamination or entrapment or any other contamination detrimental to the coating which occurs prior to installation of the Product, including, without limitation, contamination occurring during shipment of the Product to the job site or during storage at the job site.
8. This Warranty applies only for the weather side of the product. It is not valid for surfaces that have been over painted or upon which touch-up paint has been used.
9. Roof and walls cladding must be annually inspected and properly kept up. Fully documented and corroborative cleaning records must be kept for the period of the Warranty by the Customer of the building to which the Warranty reports.
10. Alcoa Architectural Products shall be given a reasonable opportunity to inspect the Product claimed to be defective. If, after inspection of the Product, Alcoa Architectural Products determines that the claim is valid, Alcoa Architectural Products shall refinish, repair, replace by the same or equivalent coating or refund the purchase price of the defective Product, at Alcoa Architectural Products' sole option.
11. All Warranty work will be performed by Alcoa Architectural Products or by a company, dealer, contractor, applicator, or distributor selected by Alcoa Architectural Products. Since there may be a colour variance between the replacement or repainted Product and the originally installed Product due to normal weathering (ie., exposure to sunlight and extremes of temperature and weather) of the originally installed Product, this condition shall not be indicative of a defect.

12. Alcoa Architectural Products reserves the right to discontinue or modify its product lines and coating colours. If the original Product or coating colour is no longer available, Alcoa Architectural Products will, at its option, either substitute a Product or coating of equal value and quality or refund the purchase price of the defective Product
13. The Warranty Period applicable to any refinished, repaired or replaced Product shall be for the then unexpired portion of the Warranty Period applicable to the originally installed Product.
14. It is understood and agreed that the remedies provided for herein are exclusive whether for breach of express warranties or otherwise and shall constitute the Customer's exclusive remedy and Alcoa Architectural Products' exclusive liability. In no event shall Alcoa Architectural Products be liable for direct, indirect, incidental, punitive, special or consequential damages. This warranty excludes all other warranties, representations or guarantees, express or implied, by operation of law or otherwise, including, without limitation, the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.
15. All claims hereunder must be submitted in writing to: Alcoa 1, rue du Ballon, F-68500 Merxheim. The claim must be accompanied by this Certificate or a copy thereof or by a reference to its date of issue, the Certificate number, and the Customer's name and address as they appear hereon. In order to qualify for warranty coverage, all claims must be submitted within thirty (30) days of the date the damage or defect is first discovered or could have been discovered and before 10% of the paint surface in a single plane becomes affected, but in no event may claims be submitted more than thirty (30) days following the expiration of the warranty period.  
For all claims, Alcoa Architectural Products' liability does not extend to the first 15 000 Euros.
16. In order for the customer to be eligible for warranty coverage, the attached warranty application must be completed, signed by the customer and Alcoa Architectural Products' officer, and returned to Alcoa Architectural Products within thirty (30) days after the shipment.
17. The delivery of the material is governed by the terms of this agreement and shall not be subject to any additional terms, conditions or provisions contained in any purchase order, order acknowledgement or other document furnished or transmitted by either party unless the other party expressly agrees in writing to such additional terms, conditions. This Warranty may not be modified or changed except by a written document signed by an officer of Alcoa Architectural Products.

In case of REYNOBOND®, Alcoa Architectural Products warrants also that the REYNOBOND® Aluminium Composite Panels furnished by Alcoa Architectural Products (the Product) to the customer will not exhibit any visually observable deformation as a result of delamination of the aluminium skin from the core material due to manufacturing defect.
