Dear Simon,

Good speaking to you earlier today with regards to the Grenfell Tower project.

Firstly, a brief summary of points discussed:

- (new) NOVA composite sample is unavailable due to NedZink's decision not to produce new panels before current (old) NOVA panels are out of stock.
- KME's sample panel should arrive in w/c 28.10.
- You expressed concerns about stability of interlocking panels (1mm thick single sheet) at the heights (66m tall building)

Referring to our discussion please consider surface fixed NOVA composite panel for cost and structural suitability reasons (= abandon interlocking panels idea)

Please find attached as requested:

- Wind loads
- Updated detail design intent for the rainscreen *1279_SEA_(06) 110_Typical Bay-DRAFT 131024*

The budget is:

- the latest cost plan I've got includes a full rainscreen (incl. Insulation) supply and install figure £ 835,900.00 (arrived to by applying £260 rate to 3,215m²)

As discussed please advise on the costs for the whole job.

As suggested it may be interesting to hear about the different Proteus panel (15mm instead of 25mm), subject to the budget allowance stated above.

I have got from Paul a sample of the new weathered zinc sheet (110x110mm) as part of the big brochure. This looks a bit duller and more textured than the (old) NOVA composite sample but will still be visually acceptable. Can you supply a bigger sample, say A4?

I'll be looking forward to hearing from you either this Friday or Monday next week.
