I was at Grenfell this morning and noticed that the bulkheads installed on floor 14 do not have any means of ventilation to the main lobby space to dissipate heat build-up. I realise that this is the 'mock-up' floor and as such may not yet represent what will be installed on the remaining floors, but just wanted to make sure that this hadn't slipped off your radar. As per our tender drawings, we'd also stated that ventilation would be required in the riser cupboard doors/wall for the same reasons.
