Please find attached comments on the plank drawings. Main observations are;

- Alu column panel should be same size as above on 212, this is a hangover from previous revision comments and we clarified on following phone call
- End jamb plank details as they abut column would be preferable if they could have recessed fixing along the lines of typical vertical plank joints
- Flashings around window opening look a bit agricultural- would be good if these could sit behind the plank to hide/ recess exposed fixings
