It is our intention to display the planning application design in the project room next to the Grenfell Tower reception

This display will be available for residents to view throughout the planning application period As residents will be aware revised Planning Application for Grenfell Tower Regeneration Project were submitted in October to RBKC Planning Department.

It was anticipated that approval would be given in December 2012 however we have been advised that this will now be assessed for approval in February 2013.

We apologise for any delay but are working with RBKC Planning Department for satisfactory conclusion inline with their planning process.

It has been brought to our attention that some residents may still have concerns or questions with the proposed plans.

We would like to encourage residents to put forward their comments to the Project Manager Paul Dunkerton. To provide you with further consultation we plan to hold drop in sessions for your benefit on dates shown overleaf.

Works are underway to make the KALC site secure and to protect residents and visitors as best as possible from site activities and potential harm.
