Thanks for these. I'll forward these comments on to JS Wright for there information. The outcome of the visit from JS Wright's Smoke Control Specialists was that he could only visually check the existing system in it's current state which as expected didn't give him enough information to provide a written report. He took note of all the equipment and product information from the existing and was going to return to his office and check to see what technical information they had on this equipment (all makes and models are slightly different). The plan is now for him to return and carry out a full test including smoke test within the ducts. I'm awaiting a return call to clarify when this will happen.

I note from the Fire notice you attached that they had given you an ultimatum date of 5th May 2014 to get things rectified. This was a month prior to us being on site. Do you know if they returned to check if the work had been carried out?

Also the Building Control Application has already been submitted and fully paid for by us. We have been allocated John Hoban as our officer. I believe he is working on the KALC project as well. Everything has to go through him in the first instance but he will refer all Fire related works to his colleague Paul Hanson. Prior to knowing your concerns about the existing AOV system we have already made introductions and had discussion with both officers about the Dry Riser.

I'll keep you updated.
