There are no dates that indicate recent installation of fire doors, within flats indicated on the attachment, certainly not as a planned maintenance programme. There are for example a few recent door installations, 2010, and maybe it is standard now (or then) to install fire doors as standard.

The only definite fire door dates (that I know of) that exist are not on Keystone, they are in Paul's folder T:\Technical Services\Capital Programme Team\Paul Dunkerton\Fire Door Replacement Programme\11 Snagging, PC, MG defects\Practical Completions\ and the related kgi which I am updating. Hesketh Place is the one block that has seen recent fire door work, and generally practical completion was on the 9th January 2012. There are no practical completion certificates for Flats in Block 4 Hesketh Place, only 6 Hesketh Place. 6 Hesketh Place does not feature on the attachment FRA Medium Risk.

A while ago I updated 2 kgis which would have put much of this information on Keystone.

Burleigh House also seems have to have Flat Entrance Door work planned under the same project as the other Fire Doors (G3466) but because it does not appear in Paul's Folder, we do not have any information as to whether they are complete. G3466 is not assigned as Planned Work in Keystone to any of the other blocks:

Ingelow House Sheffield Terrace

32 St Charles Square Allom House

Barlow House Balfour House

Corbett House 21-29 Norwood Road

In addition, Magda's November finance tracking spread sheet gives the budget for this project as pretty much fully spent, so I do not have any evidence to show that they may be, if accidentally omitted from the project on Keystone.
