2 Tenants (approach was to identify residents in the following ways:)

- housing management list of interested and available during day residents
- residents who had attended drop-ins/meetings including those with email
- looking at residents who had previously given access during the day

43 Sobieszczak	phoned, not interested (but had attended drop-ins)
35 Mrs Allcorn	left 3 messages on voicemail, no response to date (attended evening meetings plus drop in)
36 Mr Millan	door knocked, no access
75 Mrs Ghavimi	door knocked, [REDACTED]
31 Mr Griffin	door knocked, not available on the Friday
132 Sheila Sheila	door knocked, not available, [REDACTED]
122 Steve Powers	door knocked, he ruled himself out as not like works
173 Mary Mendy	door knocked, no access 2 days in row
46 Mr Vlero	door knocked, someone was in but did not answer door
143 Mrs Abdulla	door knocked, but no answer

163 Mrs Mekannen	door knocked, she was interested but [REDACTED] [REDACTED] She rung back to say she could not make any arrangements.
32 Mrs Shah	door knocked, she said she would 'pop in', but was reticent to commit to a whole day.
