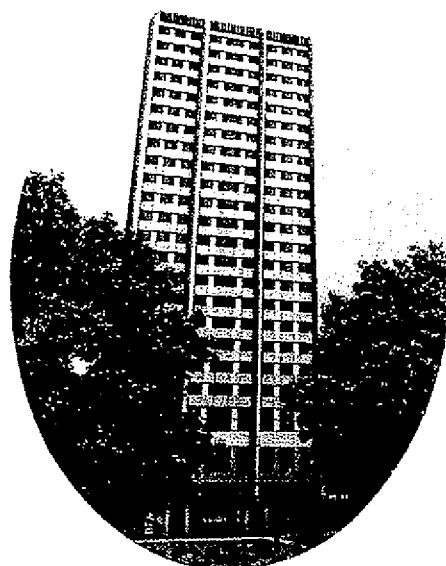

Grenfell Tower Regeneration Newsletter

Welcome to the first joint Rydon and KCTMO edition of this newsletter. Since the April newsletter we have been busy working with the Council's planning department on the type of cladding which will be used. We have also been involved in other preparatory work necessary before the actual regeneration starts.

But changes have been happening: the nursery has moved temporarily to the Resource Centre and Rydon has moved into the old nursery.

The estate services team has moved into the main Grenfell Tower office. Siobhan Rumble and her housing team will move into the old EMB meeting rooms next month. The caretakers' rooms will become a community space. Finally, the boxing club is moving nearby.

So what's next?

Over the coming months you will notice various works taking place. Here's a summary:

- site set up – containers and fencing installed
- minor alteration works to allow the temporary resident entrance at walkway level
- removal of the existing ramp from walkway level and perimeter canopy
- scaffold and mobile elevated work platform erected.

Individual letters will be issued throughout the year, with specific dates regarding works in and around your flat.

The regeneration programme

Rydon will need to survey all homes that are included in the regeneration programme before any work starting in that particular home.
