40PF GRENFELL TOWER

On mobilisation to 40 PF On Arrival the whole crew as an appliance less the O-I-C. Rigged in BA took Breathing in gear, Cleveland lay hose FIRE Bag and 2 x 45mm hose to the base of the Building

All crews were then mustered in the lobby and myself
BA

and FF Wharnsby were detailed to report to the bridgehead. Where we were given task of going to 14th Floor Flat 113 in accordance with FSS.

On ascending the stairs under air we met members of the public coming down who were suffering from smoke inhalation myself and FF Wharnsby immediately dumped our kit and led the public to safety by carrying and guiding down the stairs myself and FF Wharnsby took down to ground in 2 trips 4 Persons (1 x Adult female, 2 x teenage girls and one child) we then carried out Fireground A test.

(All were near to collapse as stair ways becoming heavily smoke logged.)

after this I dumped BA in holding area and worked in lobby with SM Walton ferrying crews and 'spotting' for falling debris etc.

my next job was to help with laying a 45mm set for the 12th floor with Cn Magee

I then heard on radio a report of a member of public waving out of window on 5th floor. I radioed BA Control to request. Wearers myself FF Benachia and one other carried out a quick search whilst awaiting crews on 5th floor but had to cease due to smoke

after this all crews in my immediate vicinity then descended to Ground Floor and left the building taking BA Set back to Appliance before reporting to Ambulance clearing area and BA Control.

All these events took place between 0220 & 0900 Approx.

I Suffered 2 injuries whilst on this incident a Sprained Ankle (left) and a small burn to face due to burning falling debris when entering lobby which was cleaned and treated by LAS.
