CALLER: There are seven – eight people inside the house.

CALLER: Can you – call I say something please? If you send helicopter from

other side you can get out (inaudible).

OPERATOR: I'm sorry, we don't have any helicopters, I'm sorry. So it's flat 193,

22nd floor, you've got eight people?

CALLER: Yeah, if you guys (several inaudible words).

OPERATOR: Okay. Can you get out at all? If you go out onto your landing is it full

of smoke?

CALLER: It's full of smoke, the fire from other side is over our building.

OPERATOR: Okay. But is the fire in the corridor?

CALLER: The fire, I don't know (several inaudible words) smoking.

OPERATOR: Okay. What you need to do if that fire starts coming in or getting

worse you need to get yourself out now, okay?

CALLER: Out where? Out where?

OPERATOR: Cover your – get some – out onto the corridors. Out your front door.

CALLER: We can't (inaudible). We are inside the house, we can't get out the

building, there is smoke everywhere, we can't see (inaudible).

OPERATOR: Okay. If you go outside your flat where's your nearest staircase?

Left or right?

CALLER: When I get outside (inaudible) stairs for me but I can't get to any

stairs because of the smoke, we can't see (inaudible).

OPERATOR: Okay. Well we are trying to get to you but it's very difficult. So all I'm

saying to you is if it gets very, very bad you need to get yourself out of

those flats, get all your eight people out, cover yourself with wet

towels, wet sheets, anything and try and get out, okay? All right?

OPERATOR: Okay. I'm going to leave you now. You make the decision whether

you think you need to leave or not, all right?

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: Okay, thank you, bye.
